Another way of making regular contributions is to set up a standing order with your bank. You can easily do this by downloading our Parish Standing Order Form which you will find on the Helpful Resources Page on our website (if you press the button it will download to a Microsoft Word file on your computer).

When you fill in the form you will find that our Bank Address, Account Name, Sort Code and Account number are already filled in. Please leave these as they are.

Can I ask that you make your payments monthly rather than weekly? This makes it easier for us when processing the bank statements (with just one entry per month rather than four).

You may wish to fill the form in on your computer and email it to your bank or, alternatively, print it out and fill it in by hand and post it. Please do not post it to us.
